Proposal for Handsworth Primary School to Convert to Academy Status with REAch2 Multi Academy Trust

## 1. Introduction

Handsworth Primary School's Governing Body has decided to embark upon a process, which may lead to conversion to academy status. The Governing Body has been investigating and considering all options in relation to academisation for a number of years and, on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2018, unanimously passed a resolution to begin the academisation process and submitted an application to the Department for Education. This resolution and application starts a period of investigation and consultation – it is not a final decision to convert. Any final decision would only be made after a further governors' meeting at the end of the consultation period.

The target date for conversion to take effect is 1st November 2018. The proposal is that Handsworth Primary School converts into an academy as part of the REAch2 Multi Academy Trust, which is the largest primary-only Multi Academy Trust in England, with almost 60 schools within the REAch2 family.

The formal consultation period runs from Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018 until 12 noon on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2018. During this period, the Governing Body will give all key stakeholders the opportunity to give their views and ask questions, including all staff and their recognised trade unions, parents, pupils and the wider community.

## 2. The Background

The Governing Body took the decision to embark upon the conversion process and potentially join REAch2 for the following reasons:

- To maintain control over the school's destiny in an ever-changing and fragile political education landscape
- To be able to provide better professional development opportunities and training for staff through REAch2
- To be able to provide further regional networking and sharing of best practice opportunities (there are 18 REAch2 schools in the North Central Region)
- To gain better quality support than we are currently receiving as a maintained school
