A reminder from the office that online payments are now due for School Dinners (£47.15 for the half term) and Music tuition (£60.00). If your child is eligible for a free school meal irrespective of whether they receive a Universal Infant School meal or prefer packed lunch, please register for free school meals via the Waltham Forest Council website. The school gains vital funding (called Pupil Premium) for every child registered, which allows us to purchase much needed resources and additional provision for these pupils. If you are eligible, your child could benefit from support towards school trips (including the Year 6 residential), sports clubs, music tuition and school uniform. Please speak to myself or the school office confidentially if you have any queries regarding this.
