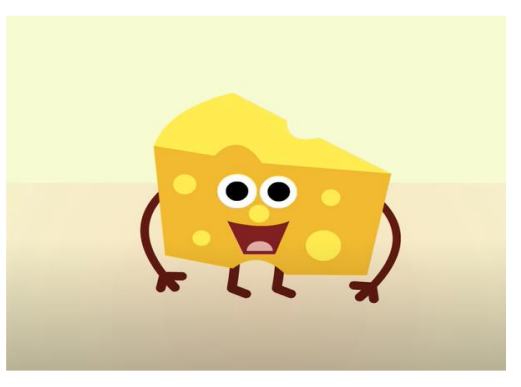

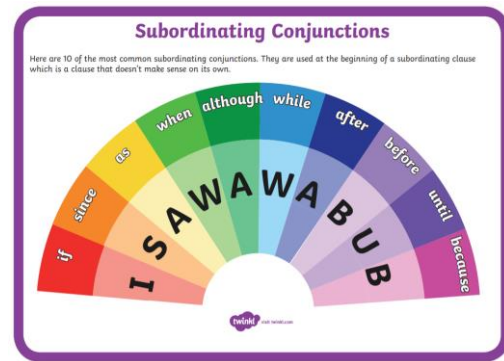

**For And Nor But Or Yet So**
