

Word Problems:

9. Liam has 8325 marbles, and he wants to give 1579 marbles to his sister. How many marbles will Liam have left?

$$8325 - 1579 = 6,746 \text{ marbles}$$

10. A school had 6987 books. They bought an additional 4275 books for the library. How many books does the school have now?

$$6987 + 4275 = 11,262 \text{ books}$$

11. Fred saved up 2371 pounds to buy a bookshelf. The bookshelf costs 1346 pounds. How much money does Thomas have left?

$$2371 - 1346 = \text{£}1,025$$

12. There were 6000 apples in the store. Sarah bought 3675 apples, and John bought 1892 apples. How many apples are left in the store?

$$3675 + 1892 = 5567$$

$$6000 - 5567 = 433 \text{ apples}$$
