# Dodos

- A Dodo is a flightless bird that is extinct.
- It weighed 13-23kg.
- Grey and brown bird with tiny wings, strong legs and a large beak.
- Until Humans the Dodo had no predators.
- Dodos went extinct in 1681.



# Dinosaurs

- Dinosaurs are a diverse group of reptiles.
- Dinosaurs are a group of reptiles that have lived on Earth for about 245 million years.
- Dinosaurs went extinct about 66 million years ago.



# Saber tooth tiger

- Saber-toothed cats went extinct between 8,000 and 10,000 years ago, as the ice age drew to an end and their prey began to die out.
- Standing up to three feet (1 m) tall at the shoulder, 5.5 feet (1.7 m) in length, and up to 750 pounds (340 kg) in weight.



# Splendid poison frog

- The splendid poison frog went extinct in 2020.
- 1.5-2 centimetres (0.5-0.7 inches) in length
- Red and black, yellow and green, orange and silver, blue and yellow, green and black, pink and silver is their colours.



# Tasmanian tiger

- The Tasmanian tiger went extinct in 7<sup>th</sup> of September 1936.
- Tasmanian tigers were 39 to 51 inches 100 to 130 centimetres long and the length is 50 to 65cm. They weighed 33 to 66 lbs.15 to 30 kilograms.
- sandy yellowish-brown to grey in colour and had 15 to 20 distinct dark stripes across the back from shoulders to tail.
