The Ten Commandments

According to Christian belief, the **Ten Commandments** are important rules from God that tell Christians how to live.

The Ten Commandments

The **first four** commandments are instructions about how humans should relate to God:

- 1. You shall worship no other God's but me
- 2. You shall not worship false idols
- 3. You shall not take the Lord's name in vain
- 4. You shall keep the Sabbath a Holy day

The Ten Commandments

The **last six** commandments are about how people should treat each other:

- 5. You shall respect your Mother and Father
- 6. You shall not commit murder
- 7. You shall not commit adultery
- 8. You shall not steal
- 9. You shall not lie
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbour's goods.

- Draw a poster advertising your commandments.
