## Staying safe online

We would like to invite you to join us on **Safer Internet Day 2019** for a workshop to highlight the issues facing our children online.

Being able to access the online world provides children with many amazing opportunities and incredible experiences. However, along with these benefits, there are a number of risks; some we are aware of and others which are less well-known.

It is clear that there is a link between the behaviour and language some children are exposed to online and their mental health and well-being, their focus, their social attitudes and their behaviour.

Our **Staying Safe Online** workshop will focus on computer games, YouTube videos, chat rooms and their associated risks.
