I hope you enjoy reading your child's report later today. Please contact the school office if you would like to discuss this further with your child's class teacher.

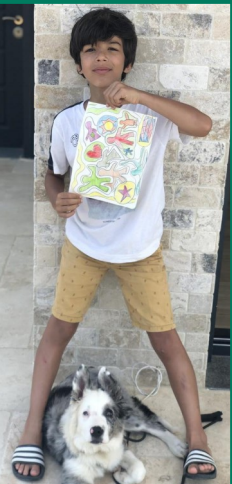
