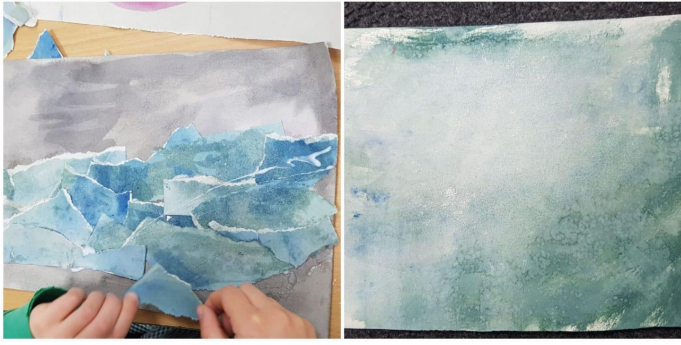
## SPORTS DAY!
